 Heirs execut<sup>r</sup> and administrat<sup>r</sup> to make good y<sup>e</sup> sale of y<sup>e</sup> above said Indian  
 girle to him y<sup>e</sup> said Parker his Heirs & assignes; and I we acknowledge to  
 have received of him y<sup>e</sup> said Parker for and in consideration of said Indian  
 garle as full satisfaction the full & just Sum<sup>e</sup> of sixteene pounds current  
 money of this province. In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand  
 and Seale this ~~twenty seventh~~ 27<sup>th</sup> day of march 1698.
