

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## TOWN OF SOUTHOLD Fall Leaf Cleanup Program

**Starting Date: NOVEMBER 20, 2017**  
**Beginning in Laurel and ending at Orient Point**

- The Highway Department will begin collecting **BAGGED LEAVES ONLY** (in biodegradable paper leaf bags) starting **Monday, November 20. There will be NO collection of brush/branches. Therefore, as of November 20 all residents should have their leaf bags ready at curbside.** Leaves are accepted at the compost site free of charge YEAR-ROUND, as long as they are delivered loose or in leaf bags.
- Only brush and branches brought in residential vehicles will be accepted free of charge from **Wednesday, November 1 through Thursday, November 30.**
- Brush brought in commercial vehicles (i.e., those with commercial disposal permits or those with a capacity greater than one-ton) will be charged \$30/ton (1/2 the regular rate).
- All yard waste must be free from any plastic, garbage or other debris as it will not be picked up or accepted at the Transfer Station compost site.
- Single-entry fees for vehicles without permits are not waived and **WILL STILL BE CHARGED!**
