

PUBLIC NOTICE

TOWN OF SOUTHOLD Fall Leaf Cleanup Program

Starting Date: November 16, 2020

Beginning in Laurel and ending at Orient Point

- The Highway Department will begin collecting **BAGGED LEAVES ONLY** (in biodegradable paper leaf bags) starting **Monday, November 16. There will be NO collection of brush/branches. Therefore, as of November 16 all residents should have their leaf bags ready at curbside.** Leaves are accepted at the compost site free of charge YEAR ROUND, as long as they are delivered loose or in leaf bags.
- Only brush and branches brought in residential vehicles will be accepted **free of charge until Tuesday, December 1, 2020.**
- Brush brought in commercial vehicles (i.e., those with commercial disposal permits or those with a capacity greater than one ton) will be charged \$30/ton (1/2 the regular rate).
- All yard waste must be free from any plastic, garbage or other debris as it will not be picked up or accepted at the Transfer Station compost site.
- Single-entry fees for vehicles without permits are not waived and **WILL STILL BE CHARGED!**
