## WHEN VISITING THE BEACH

The following permits are available at the Town Clerk's Office and are valid at all Town beaches with the exception of New Suffolk. New Suffolk is limited to Town Residents only.

### RESIDENTS GUESTS LESSEE/RENTERS HOTELS/MOTELS

When vacating your vehicle or for those arriving on foot or being dropped off at one of the beaches, the following identification will be requested of the party. Note New Suffolk Beach is for Town Residents only or people who are accompanied by a Resident of the Town:

**RESIDENTS:** Divers license, car registration, tax bill, utility bill or student I.D.

**GUEST:** Show receipt from the purchase of a guest pass.

**LESSEE/RENTERS:** Show receipt from the purchase of a Lessee/Renters pass.

**HOTELS/MOTELS:** Pass in hand from hotel/motel.

Please remember, COVID distancing is required, so beach occupancy limits still apply (i.e. New Suffolk Max = 100 people)
